Phillips-Wasatch Credit Union is offering three \$300 Textbook Scholarship Awards for the 2010/2011 school year.

Eligibility

All applicants must be members of Phillips-Wasatch Credit Union prior to submitting the attached application. Only those eligible for post secondary education (includes trade and technical school) enrollment will be considered.

How to Apply

All eligible applicants will need to complete this application form to be considered. The completed application must be received in the credit Union Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday August 13, 2010. Applications received after the August 13, 2010 deadline will not be considered.

Selection Criteria

The selection of the recipients of this scholarship will be based on the applicant's academic achievements, leadership skills, scholarship need, community service, and scholastic goals. A committee selected by PWCU will determine the scholarship recipients.

Winner Notification

The winners of the Textbook Scholarship will be notified by mail in September by the Scholarship Committee.

Award Conditions

After proof of registration has been provided to the Scholarship Committee, recipient will be reimbursed for books purchased. Receipts will be required.
